

PRIVACY POLICY FOR VISITORS OF THE WEBSITE

Dear user,

We thank you for visiting our website. In the following you will find all important information in order to understand the purposes and the modalities of the processing of your personal data as visitor and all the information as provided for in the articles 13 and 14 of the EU General Data Protection Regulation 2016/679, Which is a regulation in EU law on data protection and privacy for all individuals within the European Union (EU) and the European Economic Area (EEA) (in the following “GDPR”).

1. Who is the Owner of the processing?

The Owner of the processing is Industria Grafica Eurostampa S.p.A. with registered office in Viale Rimembranza 20 – 12041 Bene Vagienna (CN) – Italy (in the following, “Eurostampa”), which contacts are available in the section “Contacts”.

2. What kind of data do we process and how long do we store them?

a) Browsing data

Computer systems and software procedures responsible for the functioning of this website acquire some data in the normal operation and only during the connection. These data will be implicitly transferred to the use of protocols of internet communication.

This information is not collected in order to associate it with the users, but, by nature, it might permit to identify them, through processing and matching with data managed by third parties. This data are deleted a few hours after the processing.

b) Cookies

This website uses technology such as cookies, which technically are packets of information sent by a web server (this website, in this case) to the browser of the user and by the latter stored in his own device (personal computer, tablet, smartphone, etc.) and sent automatically to the server at any further access to the site.

In order to know the types and purposes of cookies used by Eurostampa’s websites and to show your preferences about the use of cookies, please see *Cookie policy*.

c) Data voluntarily provided by users/visitors

While connecting to this website, if you decide to send your personal data where it is provided for (for example: name, surname and email address) in order to be able to reach certain services or write through electronic mail, Eurostampa will process these data to answer to your request or to provide you the service required, in conformity with this policy and with the specific privacy policy agreed with the access to the service. The data will be stored for the necessary time in order to provide the service and in case there are any objections.

You will not be asked about your health or in general about specific categories of personal data as provided for in the article 9 of the GDPR (sensitive, biometric, genetic, criminal data).

3. In which way are your data processed?

Your data are processed with the support of computer and telematics devices and they are protected with adequate security measures, in order to guarantee discretion and integrity.

In particular, Eurostampa has taken and takes adequate organisational measures (distribution of roles and responsibilities in the execution of activities and controls), procedural measures and technical measures (firewall, antivirus, and other advanced technologies) which protect your data from loss, theft, non-authorized use, disclosure or change.

4. Which are the purposes and the legal basis of the processing?

Eurostampa processes your anonymous navigation data (see 2.a) in order to monitor the technical functioning and the performances of the website, with the purpose of improving the services and developing them. These data are necessary to guarantee the provision of the website.

The data in point 2.b are used in order to obtain anonymous statistics on the use of the website and to check the correct functioning (they are therefore necessary to guarantee the provision of the website) and to show some advertisement, as better explained in our *Cookie Policy*.

When the services provided from the website are free and supported by advertisement, the legal basis of the processing is the legitimate interest of the Owner as explicitly provided for in the GDPR. (See above point 2.b).

As far as the data in point 2.c are concerned, we invite you to read the specific information about each service which will be gradually published, depending on the possibility of the website.

5. To whom might your data be provided?

The anonymous data in point 2.a and 2.b might be provided to partners and suppliers, who support Eurostampa in the provision of this website. If Eurostampa provides your personal data to third parties (for example concerning the services for which you registered), these will act as autonomous Owners or they will be appointed by Eurostampa as Managers for processing.

In addition, your data might be provided to individuals, bodies and authorities, for whom the data provision is compulsory by law.

6. Which are your rights?

At any time you can have access to the information about you and ask for updating, rectification, integration or cancellation, transformation to anonymised form or blocking. You could also fully or partially object to the processing.

In addition, you have the right to address the Guarantor for the protection of the personal data or to another authority in order to complain about your personal data processing.
